II Corinthians-Chapter 9

I. Continued Greeting on Giving

- A. Already doing the work, but being prepared for inspection (1-5)
- B. You reap what you sow (6-7)
- C. God is able (8-11)
- D. Giving for service and giving as a witness (12-15)

Summary

Paul is still discussing generosity in this passage (reaping and sowing), and then he goes on to talk about how giving can have more than one purpose. He believes that by their sacrifice, the men and women of the church will attract others to Christ as they see the church's good works.
